

Waltham Abbey u3a social media policy

Focus on maintaining a respectful, safe, and positive online environment that aligns with charity guidelines. Key requirements include, but are not limited to, using respectful language, protecting member privacy (no sharing personal data/photos without consent), avoiding political or religious debate, and not bringing the u3a into disrepute.

Key Aspects of u3a Social Media Policies:

- **Code of Conduct:** Posts must be courteous, kind, and professional; bullying, harassment, or intimidation is strictly prohibited.
- **Privacy & Consent:** Members' privacy must be respected. Explicit consent is needed for posting photos of individuals.
- **Accuracy:** Members should not share unverified, misleading, or confidential information.
- **Content Restrictions:** Content should be relevant to u3a activities. Avoid contentious topics like politics or religion and refrain from personal business advertising.
- **Account Management:** Official social media pages should be managed by authorized administrators/moderators, who must ensure that posted information aligns with the organization's goals.
- **Personal Accounts:** When posting, members should make it clear that they are speaking for themselves, not on behalf of the organization, unless authorized.
